



**Introduction**

Following the decision of Her Majesty’s Government (HMG) and the Welsh Assembly Government (WAG) to institute a ‘lockdown’ of the United Kingdom on 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2020 the fishery has been closed.

During our planned phased release from lockdown the fishery guiding principles will be to:

1. Do everything necessary to ensure the health of anglers, visitors and our staff is protected, and
2. Minimise the potential for the transfer of the virus by fully complying with all directives and guidance issued by WAG, HMG, Conwy County Borough Council (CCBC) and National Resources Wales (NRW).

Rest assured we will not compromise on these guiding principles. Anyone not prepared to adopt a similar position should look to fish somewhere other than here at Tan-y-Mynydd. The above guiding principles have been set in a bid to recognise that the demographics of our clientele tends to older people. As such we recognise that your health and well-being has to be our number one priority.

**Executive Summary**

If you have been diagnosed with COVID-19 or suspect you are displaying its symptoms then please do NOT compromise the safety of yourself or others by trying to book a slot with us. As part of the booking process you will be required to confirm that you are clear of COVID-19 or its symptoms. If on arrival or at any time whilst on site we suspect you may be infected you will NOT be permitted to enter the fishery or asked to leave.

We recognise that there are families who come fishing at Tan-y-Mynydd and as such we wish to continue to welcome them. In order that we can accommodate small family groups, who have isolated together, it is vital that until we are officially advised otherwise by HMG, WAG or CCBC anyone travelling to the fishery must do so either alone or only with one person with whom they have been in isolation. Any failure to advise of shared isolation at the time of booking will unfortunately result in access to the fishery being denied, without a refund.

Overall, it can be seen from the table below detailing how we plan to return gradually back to whatever the ‘new normal’ looks like, that the TWO critical things anglers need to do are as follows:

1. **Ensure you are booked in with the fishery in advance of even thinking of leaving home.**  
**REMEMBER: No pre-booked Slot = No Access to the Fishery (Applies to Phases 1 to 3 inclusive)**
2. **Abide by WAG & HMG guidelines plus our rules and we will all get along fine. If you cannot agree to abiding by our rules and national guidelines then please do NOT come to Tan-y-Mynydd**
