6/001	Fishery (Overall)	Spread of COVID-19 Coronavirus	Infection by the virus through airborne or surface transmission High	All visitors and staff	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> WAG restrictions and rules to be strictly adhered to by all and take precedence over UK govt position UK government guidance and rules to be strictly applied Strict limit on number of anglers per session to be operated All anglers to confirm they are free of COVID-19 or its symptoms as part of the booking and then again at time of booking in site Social distancing (2.0m gap between people) to be strictly enforced Hand washing to be undertaken and staff / anglers strongly recommended to do the same at regular intervals Regular surface cleaning to be undertaken around WC facilities and lodge Only staff to access the lodge Lodge WC only to be used by staff and disabled anglers 	Medium	<p>Hard copy record of each angler session to be retained for minimum of 6 weeks, all to assist with track and trace of any suspected infected persons. <u>After 6 weeks hardcopy records will be carefully destroyed as confidential waste</u></p> <p>Persons 'shielding' or isolating with a person who is 'shielding' to be strongly recommended NOT to come fishing</p> <p>All used barrier PPE i.e. gloves, tissues etc to be carefully transported and then burned in local incinerator at frequent intervals</p>



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		Spread of COVID-19 Coronavirus (Continued)			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pre-booking of fishing sessions to be required Anglers to be provided with guidance notes on arrival at the fishery • Access to grounds to be controlled • Number of anglers allowed on site to be strictly limited • Social distancing and other suitable reminder notices to be displayed at suitable points around the fishery • Signage, cleaning fluids and disposable towels to be provided at WC facilities • Preference for payments to be made via cashless means. • Where money is used all received cash to be soaked in disinfectant / bleach. No change to be given, credit notes to be provided to affected anglers 		<p>Recommend to anglers that they disinfect their tackle before arriving and then on returning home</p> <p>Recommend to anglers that they bring refreshments with them</p> <p>Anglers and staff not to share refreshments with anyone other than those in the same household</p>



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		Spread of COVID-19 Coronavirus (Continued)			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No anglers, other than family members co-isolating to share tackle • Car parking to be managed by staff so as to ensure social distancing is assisted • No food or beverages to be provided to anglers. This to be advised to them at time of booking a session • No hiring of tackle to take place • No lessons to be given on site • Tackle sales to be sight selection only, no handling prior to purchase • Tan-y-Mynydd Post Lockdown phasing protocol to be displayed on site • A copy of this risk assessment to be posted on lodge notice board
